2022-2023 Kansas High School Rodeo Association Responsibility Agreement

As a member of KHSRA, it is your responsibility to meet the following responsibilities and obligations. If any KHSRA member or parent has any questions about these responsibilities, please feel free to contact your State President, National Director, State Secretary or a KHSRA Board member. Please read the following agreement and send a signed copy with your membership information to the State Secretary. Make and retain a copy for your records.

NEW BEGINNING THE 2022-2023 SEASON FOR HIGH SCHOOL MEMBERS – CALENDARS WILL NOT BE AN OPTION TO SELL. Upon feedback from members, the board voted to come up with a new fundraiser as an option for members. The total amount required to turn in per high school member is still \$400. You will still have 2 options:

1. Turn in cash donations in the amount of \$400

2. Sell raffle tickets for the item being raffled (details will outlined each season, but it will be something like a side by side or equivalent.

If you choose to sell raffle tickets, it will be your responsibility to pick these up at the first rodeo of the fall season so that you have them. If you join after the first rodeo, you will need to ask for the tickets in the rodeo office if that is the option you choose for raising money.

ALSO NEW THIS YEAR – $\frac{1}{2}$ of the money will be due NO LATER THAN the Sunday of the last rodeo of the fall season. The other $\frac{1}{2}$ of the money will be due NO LATER than January 7th, 2023. If you fail to miss either deadline a \$100 late fee will apply.

<u>New 2022 spring members</u>, will be required to acquire \$400 in donations turned into me by April 1, 2023 Members joining in the spring have the option of selling raffle tickets as well, but you will need to make sure to ask Suzan Adams for them at your 1st rodeo that you attend.

Your signature below acknowledges the following:

- 1. You agree to turn in the minimum required \$400.
- 2. You agree to turn in at least half of the money (\$200) by the last fall rodeo of the season. If you won't be at the last fall rodeo, it must be mailed in enough time that it is received by Suzan Adams by the last fall rodeo.
- You agree to turn in the other half of the money (if you did not turn in the full amount) by the January 7th, 2023.
- 4. I understand that there is a \$100 late fee for not meeting the deadlines.
- 5. I understand that I am not eligible to rodeo in the spring unless the full amount has been paid.

As parents of the KHSRA member, you agree to be financially responsible for this mandatory requirement.
